The Blessings of God are for those who are Sanctified

The blessings of God are given as gifts of His grace to those who become His dear children through Christ. They are to inherit His blessing. God is light; there is absolutely no darkness or sin in Him. (1 John 1:5) All His blessings are "light blessings." They absolutely will not come upon spiritual darkness. The reason is that darkness is ruled by Satan who opposes God. God will never bless Satan. Acts 26:18 declares, "To open their eyes, and to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan unto God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins, and inheritance among them which are sanctified by faith that is in me." Those who accept Jesus Christ Lord of their lives must be turned from darkness to light to inherit the blessings already prepared for an abundant life in Christ.

Before Christ, our heart contained and were dominated by natural thoughts, wicked imaginations, sinful desires and wicked ways.
